Why aren't Credit Union directors compensated similarly to the CEO and executive officers, which is based on the degree of competencies and performance requirements they must have to effectively govern the credit union? Comparable credit union asset sizes does not equate to similar director competency levels and performance requirements. Credit Unions set individual capital targets, levels of commercial and retail credit risk, or branch and corporate office design based on their own needs and risk appetite. Why would you apply a one-size-fits-all approach to director compensation?

Good governance suggests that directors must have sufficient knowledge, skills and abilities to successfully govern and lead their credit union. As the regulatory environment moves rapidly towards models of ongoing education and greater accountability, director's compensation practices and models should strategically align with considerations of what is effective for each individual credit union. In this session, learn how to take a proactive approach to good governance by linking a strategic compensation system to your Board of directors.
